Brief Programme Details:

Sasmira's Business School organized six-days and five nights visit to Jodhpur and Jaisalmer from 23rd February to 28th February, 2019 for PGDM students. 45 students were accompanied in this trip along with two faculty members. On reaching Jodhpur, the students were taken for local sightseeing to Mehrangarh Fort and Umaid Bhawan in the evening. Mehrangarh Fort which is the highest elevation point of the city gives a complete view to the old settlement of Jodhpur. The students witnessed the panoramic view of the 'Blue City' from the majestic Mehrangarh Fort. After that, the students visited Umaid Bhawan, wherein the ruling family of Jodhpur has converted a part of the gigantic Umaid Bhawan Palace as a Palace Museum. The next day the students proceeded to Jaisalmer.

Students had visited Ramgarh Gas thermal Power Station and Windmills in Jaisalmer where they were explained about the process of generating electricity. In Jaisalmer the students a

day prior to the visit enjoyed site seeing of Sam sand dunes with camel riding. In the night they enjoyed folk dances of Jaisalmer in Tent camping along with camp fire. Thus, the stay at the desert camps in Jaisalmer was a splendid experience. The famed sunset over the Sam sand dunes followed by folk programs and authentic Rajasthani dinner the previous evening had left all of us in rapt. And here we were at the break of dawn bidding adieu to the mystical golden expanse of the desert land all set for our departure, heading towards Jodhpur station. Faculty members Dr. Niyat Shetty and Dr. Pashmeen Kaur Anand accompanied and supervised the trip. Overall it was a great learning experience for the students on the Land of Sand.
